

Red Arrow Snowmobile ATV Club Inc. invites all riders in either sport to join our club. The club was founded in 1968 and is now the 7th largest snowmobile club in the state of Wisconsin. We have about 480 family, single and Booster members from the area and all over Wisconsin. Member meetings are held on the 2nd Wednesday of the month from October thru March. Our annual meeting is held early in May on a Saturday, at which time officers and directors are elected.

We groom our trails with Two Tucker Sno-Cat 2000 units. Winter grooming is done many times during the week and weekends depending on snow conditions. Some snowmobile trails are not open to ATVs and UTVs at any time of the year due to Forest Service regulations and private landowner easements.

Club members volunteer around 1000 or more hours per year to the club. Our winter trails are prepared in the fall by removing the downed trees from summer storms, and then brush them with a "Brush Hog" mounted to our John Deere tractor. The John Deere tractor also pulls a Bonnell trail groomer which prepares a smooth base for the winter snow. Our summer trails are also maintained by volunteers to ensure a safe enjoyable ride for riders.

The Red Arrow's annual fundraisers include a Fish-A-Ree the 3rd weekend in February and a Corn Roast the Saturday of Labor Day weekend.

The club offers both snowmobile and ATV safety classes each year. Anyone born after 1-1-1985 must have a valid snowmobile safety certificate. Any ATV/UTV operator born after 1-1-1988 must have a valid safety certificate.

All riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet when riding an ATV or UTV. Most town roads in the Town of Townsend are open for ATV/UTV travel 12 months of the year. The town requires that headlights be on at all times for safety reasons. All riders must keep to the right side of the road and ride in single file. It is not legal to ride ATVs or UTVs on closed snowmobile trails, County T or State Highway 32.

Red Arrow is committed to providing safe and responsible snowmobile and ATV/UTV riding in the Townsend area. Our trails and routes cross many different public and private lands and include the Nicolet State Trail in our area. Please follow all speed limit and regulatory signs. Failure to follow the rules jeopardizes our trail system. Please ride responsibly at all times.
