Treasurer Report

- \$16,631.60 in the savings account. \$48,779.42 in a Money Market, 2 Certificate of Deposits. One at \$111,768.41 And another at \$109,898.78. Both are earning 3-3.5%.
- Total assets are \$932,113.00. We have approximately 250,000.00 in cash. The rest are assets.
- Total revenue for 2025 was \$44,497. For 2024 it was \$ 45, 217.
- Total expenses for 2025 were \$22,805.
- Net profit for 2025 was \$21,792 compared to \$24,996 for 2024.
- Total equity is \$937,976.11. Our club is healthy.

Membership Secretary Report

- Thank you to those who brought a non-perishable item for the local pantry.
- We have 375 members. 315 primary members and 60 secondary members. We have lost a few members due to moving, no longer have machines or are deceased.

Administrative Secretary Report

- We will have new merchandise at Snowfest. Long sleeve T-Shirt, ladies zipper jacket, sweatshirt w/o hood.

Correspondence

- Let's Ride Expo is May 1-2, 2026, at the Sunnyview Expo Center in Oshkosh. Put on by WATVA.

- Logging will be done on the Wildwood Trail and the Spring Lake Trail. We don't know when they will start.
- We will have new ATV/UTV maps for 2026-2027.
- Snowmobile maps for 2026-2028 are being worked on now.
- Trails opened January 2, 2026. They are now closed in the hope to save our base.

Trail Boss Report

- Buildings and grounds are good. Lumber Jake power washed our main building.
- We have a new sign for the building. Justin ordered the sign. We will hang it this spring.
- The snowmobile equipment is in good condition. Tracks were tightened and the 2016 needed new batteries. The tractor is at Riesterer and Schnell for maintenance for just under \$4,000.
