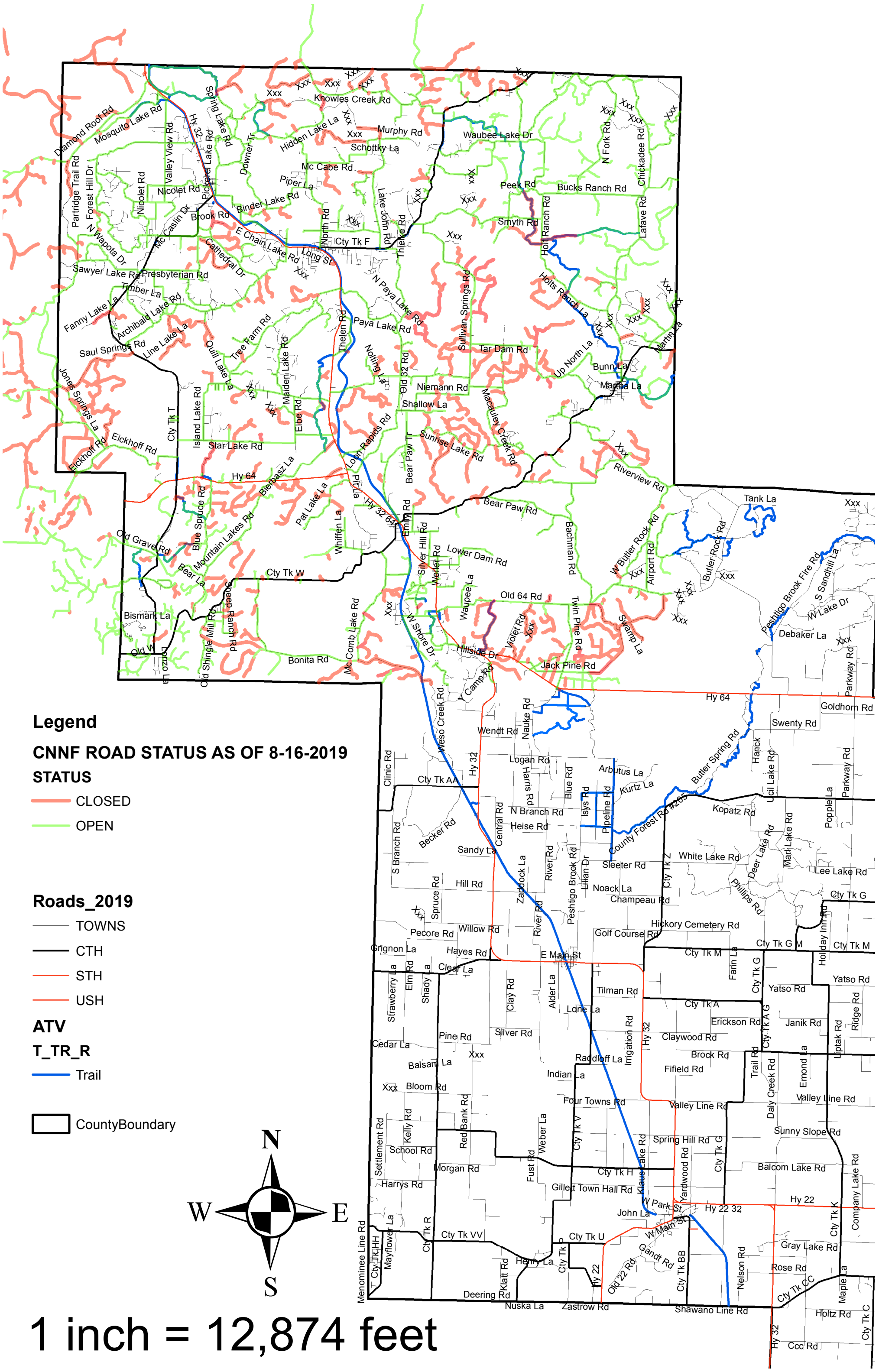
**OCONTO COUNTY ATV TRAILS WILL OPEN THURSDAY, AUGUST 29, 2019.**

Please be advised that as of August 29, 2019 all ATV trails funded by Oconto County will be open for travel. The attached map shows the location of Oconto County trails that will be open for travel (Depicted in color BLUE).

Please be advised that segments of the trail are connected by Town and US Forest Service roads. Visitors are reminded to check the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest website (<https://www.fs.usda.gov/detail/cnnf/landmanagement/?cid=fseprd644781>) before visiting for the latest updates on what is open and closed. A closure order is in place for roads, trails and recreation sites that were damaged during the storm. Visitors should also contact each townships for riding ATVs on town roads.

Please review the updated maps and plan out a route before riding. Riding on closed roads and trails may result in law enforcement action.

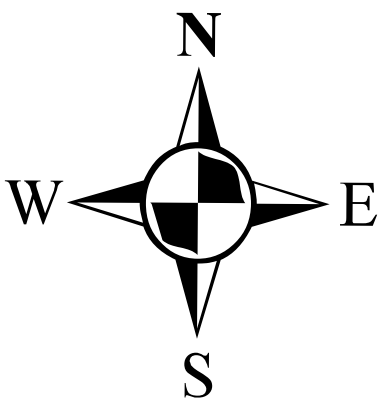
